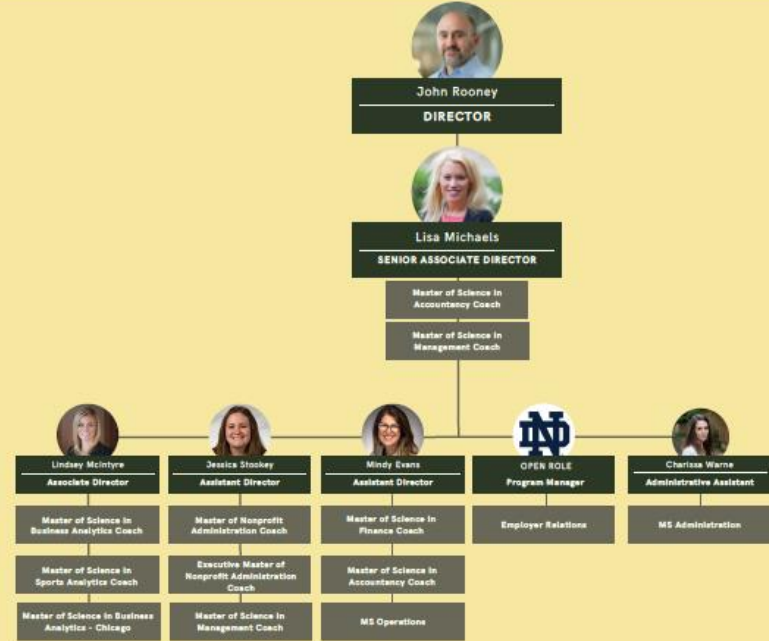

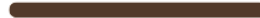

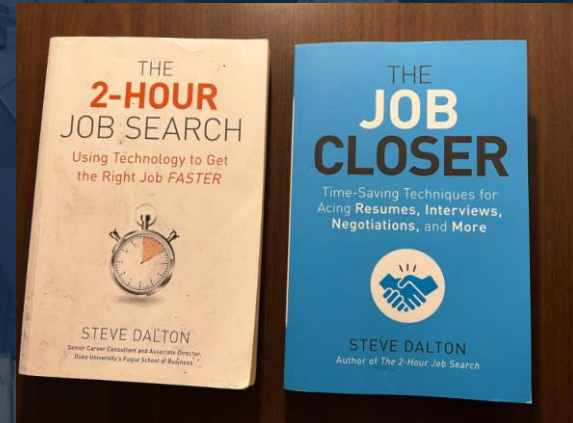

Express gratitude through thank you notes

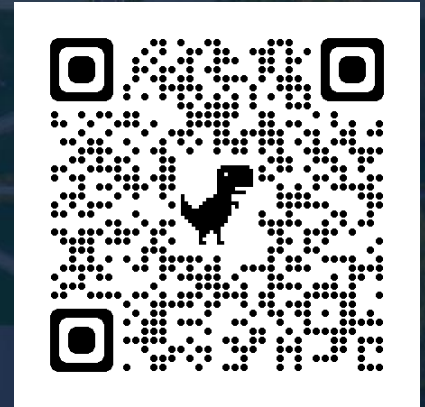

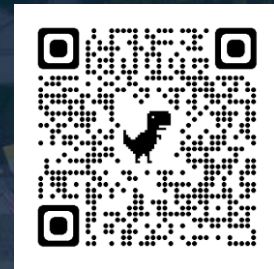
